Notification regarding a Foreign Language (English) Examination  
in April 2018 Admission or later

\* The time of submission of score certificates has been changed from 'during the designated application period' to 'on the day (of the written examination/ the special admission)'. The following points marked in blue have been revised.

### **[Important Notice]**

**The foreign language (English) examination of the special admission for Master's program is newly based on scores from TOEIC or TOEFL tests, in April 2018 admission or later.**

**Score Certificates from TOEIC or Score Reports from TOEFL must be submitted ~~during the designated application period~~ on the day of the examination for Master's and Doctoral programs, and the special admission for Master's program, in April 2018 admission or later.**

Applicants for the above admissions are required to take a TOEIC or TOEFL test and submit the score certificate or report ~~during the designated application period~~ on the day of the written examination/ the special admission.

Submit a score certificate from a test taken in the last two years counting from the last date of the designated application period. In the case of April 2018 admission, the valid score certificates are the ones from the test taken between October 19, 2015 and October 18, 2017.

Applicants should get the detailed information of the admission in the application guidelines. Test dates can be confirmed on the official website of TOEIC or TOEFL shown below.

The Graduate School of Engineering is expecting to be reorganized into the Graduate School of Engineering Science (tentative name) in April 2018 (application filed).

The foreign language (English) examination of the written examination for Master's and Doctoral programs, and the special admission for Master's program at the Graduate School of Engineering Science (tentative name), is based on scores from TOEIC or TOEFL tests. Score certificates or score reports (collectively called "score certificates") from the following tests are reviewed in the examination. Applicants should get the detailed information of the tests on the official website of TOEIC or TOEFL.

\* **Performance in TOEIC Bridge, TOEIC Speaking & Writing Test, or institutional testing programs such as TOEIC IP and TOEFL ITP is not acknowledged.**

- Submit a score certificate ~~during the application period~~ on the day of the written examination/ the special admission. **(Original only, no copies are accepted. The same rule applies elsewhere.)**
- Submit a score certificate from a test taken **in the last two years** counting from the last date of the designated application period. *In the case of April 2018 admission, the valid score certificates are the ones from the test taken between October 19, 2015 and October, 18 2017.* If an applicant have taken multiple tests, submit the certificate with the best total score. If an applicant *submits an invalid certificate or fails to submit a certificate on the day of written examination/ the special admission,* a score of 0 is assigned for the applicant's examination on foreign language (English).
- Submit a score certificate **with a photo of the applicant's face.**
- TOEIC scores are converted according to the following table into a scale of 100 points and are counted as the examination on foreign language (English).
- Submitted score certificates will not be returned to applicants.

Conversion method for TOEIC scores

TOEIC	Conversion method	Foreign language (English)
349 points or less	0	0 point
350–500 points	$(\text{TOEIC} - 350) / 3$	0–50 points
500–800 points	$(\text{TOEIC} - 500) / 6 + 50$	50–100 points
801 points or more		100 points

- TOEFL scores are converted into TOEIC scores, which are again converted into scores in examination on foreign language (English).
    - ▶ TOEFL iBT scores are converted into TOEFL PBT scores according to the conversion table presented on the next page.
    - ▶ TOEFL PBT scores are converted into TOEIC scores by the formula  $(\text{TOEFL PBT score} - 296) / 0.348 = \text{TOEIC score}$ .
- \* Scores are rounded to the nearest whole number.
